Slip Resist Achieves a wonderful smoked pattern, recommend sealing piece when complete to maintain look. Works best on a smooth or burnished bisqued piece. Sponged, dipped or brushed to a thickness of 1/8 inch to 1/4. Allow to air dry until fine line cracks appear in a pattern. Handle very gently after dry to ensure slip resist does not fall off piece. Place in kiln fire then reduce. Remove from reduction while still hot and gently scrape black residue from piece. Matt Finish. Turquoise Gloss Anything from turquoise to red copper flashes. This glaze definitely changes over time. The red copper flashes can be a little difficult to get with this glaze. This glaze settles badly, so we recommend you mix only what you will use each day. We sieve this glaze through at least an eighty mesh screen. Tutti Frutti A perfect Tutti Frutti forms multi color to red flashes to totally red copper. We have even gotten the occasional silver and blues. Glaze can be Matt to gloss depending on how much you use. If green is what you want, expose to more air before placing in reduction material. Greens & Blues. White Crackle This is a very dependable crackle glaze that smooths out easily, with nice soft white colors.
