FOR MOIST PUG CLAYS 3

TW BUFF Reduction Body/Oxidation Body (cone 8-10)

This stoneware finishes to a cream buff color with oxidation and warm toast with reduction. This coarser clay can be used for wheelwork and hand building of both small and larger pieces.

BLACK CLAY Black Stoneware (cone 5-10)

Black clay fires to a warm black color at cone 10 and is one of our newest clay bodies. The more you reduce it the blacker it becomes. Note at cone 5/6 it is a wonderful red brown. Great in any cone 10 firing whether oxidation, reduction, wood or salt fire.
